



ICC AFTER SCHOOL CLASSROOM STANDARDS & DISCIPLINE POLICY

Children will practice and learn to:

- Enter and exit the room/car in a quiet and orderly manner.
- Be good listeners to other adults/teachers/instructors as well as all classmates.
- Show care and safety when using school materials and equipment.
- Show respect to other children and to adults.
- Keep hands and feet to oneself.
- Be cooperative and helpful.
- Follow car rules. Children will be required to sit on booster car seats and buckle up before the car is in motion.
- The children will need to respect the teacher driving and follow instructions.

Classroom Discipline Policy:

The children will be rewarded for good behavior with positive comments. To commend on their behavior, special helper jobs/roles will be assigned to them.

For children with inappropriate behaviors, such pushing, pulling, kicking, and hitting others, the following will be implemented, after having given three reminders to the child

- The teacher will discuss the behaviors and work out a solution together with the child
- Move him for a few minutes to a different study desk for quiet time
- Discuss the situation with the child’s parents to implement strategies

For a worst case scenario, the parents may be requested to pick up the child for the day. If a child has difficulties or behaviors that are consistent and continues to put the health, safety, and welfare of him/herself and other children at risk, then the possibility of withdrawal from the program, as per our policies, will be discussed with the parents and implemented. Proper termination procedures will be followed as per the school contract. Please read, sign, and submit this document.
